PRODUCT OVERVIEW



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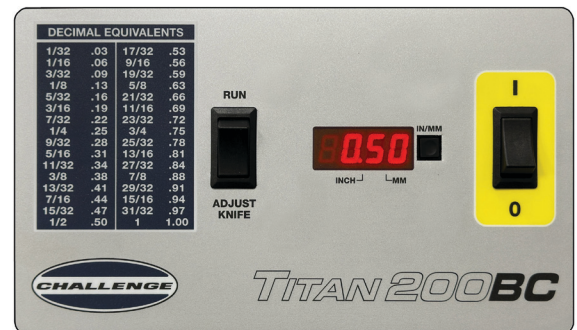
The Titan 200BC manual cutter delivers hydraulic powered knife and clamp strength, durability, and accuracy with an easy to use manual backgauge adjustment control. Simply turn the front table hand wheel to the desired cut using the digital display dimension OR visually using the optical red cut line light on the paper. The 20" opening of the Titan 200BC is a perfect size for handling up to 11"x17" stocks in the cutting area and can accurately cut piles of stock up to 3.25" high. The USA made Titan 200BC is on wheels with lockable casters allowing the machine to be easily relocated.

TITAN 200BC FEATURES

- 20" cutting width for stacks up to 3.25" high
- Hydraulic clamping and cutting - 2,500 lbs. pressure
- 120 volt 1-phase power required - optional 220 volt motor for faster machine cycles
- Adjustable clamp pressure
- Maximum cut 20" / minimum cut .5" (or 1-7/8" with false clamp plate)
- Red LED optical cut line-light indicator
- Energy efficient - motor only runs during cut cycle
- Machine dimensions 36" wide (tilt shield) x 50-7/8" deep
- Optional false clamp plate - reduces clamping impressions on the paper
- Optional pre-clamp foot pedal to clamp stocks before cutting
- Optional light beam system to replace the front tilt shield securing the cut area
- One inlaid carbon knife, three cutting sticks, wood jogging aid, tool kit, knife change holder assembly, and operator/s manual included
- 1-year warranty
- Manufactured in the USA

SAFETY FEATURES

- Tilt shield or light beam system protects the operator from the cutting area during the cut cycle
- Simultaneous and constant two hand cut button activation
- Wooden jogging aid (safer than ones made of plastic)
- UL, cUL, and CE certified
